

SIGN UP FOR THE SHOP & DROP PROGRAM!

Jewish Family Service of MetroWest NJ will pair you with a volunteer to shop for you on a weekly or biweekly basis.

HOW DOES THE SHOP & DROP PROGRAM WORK?

Your volunteer will call for your grocery list and schedule a time to drop off your groceries. You can work with them on the store you prefer. Your volunteer will pay for your groceries at the store and you must reimburse them via check when they drop your groceries off.

THIS PROGRAM IS FREE OF CHARGE.

We accept clients from Essex County, Morris County, & surrounding areas. Clients must have the ability to reimburse the volunteer.

SIGN UP TO BE A SHOP & DROP VOLUNTEER!

Jewish Family Service of MetroWest NJ will pair you with an older adult client to shop for weekly or every other week.

HOW DOES THE SHOP & DROP PROGRAM WORK?

Volunteers call the client directly to get the grocery list and then go shopping. Volunteers and clients will work together to determine timing and which store to shop at. Shopping can be done on evenings and weekends or during the work week.

We accept clients from Essex County, Morris County, and the surrounding areas.

Volunteers must complete a background check.

Time commitment is once a week or every other week but the schedule is flexible.

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
